### Board briefed on Gregg Lake Watershed Plan

The Antrim Select Board was briefed on the Gregg Lake Watershed Plan. A committee comprised of local residents around Gregg Lake, members of the Conservation Commission, Parks and Recreation, Water and Sewer and the Select Board have been meeting for several months and have completed most of the 32 items on a checklist from the EPA. When finished, the Town will be able to apply for EPA grants to help with the pollution and erosion in and around the lake. Some things have been completed, like the available water quality data has been analyzed and they've completed watershed surveys, including land use, erosion hotspots and septic systems. They currently have a 10-year plan that will encompass both public and private properties, with the time table being adjustable as necessary. Four possible remedies may include lowering the lake level (a public hearing will be scheduled for 2/24/20), to post and enforce current boating laws, to lower the HP limit from 150 to 100 (through the NH Legislature), and to increase the "no wake" zone. Run off from roads such as White Birch Point Rd. and Holt Hill Rd. contribute to sediment and will be addressed as well.
